<p>Summary</p> <p>Wearing a bracelet is a common custom among the Bunong. Both men and women wear a bracelet made of copper. Bunong villagers start wearing a bracelet at the age of 30. However, if they are married, they can start wearing a bracelet earlier, i.e., at the age of 20. Bunong villagers used to wear as many as 20 to 30 bracelets. They then exchanged a bracelet with a cow. Under the Khmer Rouge regime, bracelets, as well as traditional clothes and other valuable things were confiscated from the Bunong. Recently, not many Bunong villagers have bracelets and wear them.</p>
