They invite their fellow villagers to join the celebration and drink wine together. Invited villagers donate a small amount of money for the newborn baby.</p> <p>When the second baby is born, the parents offer only a chicken and a jar of wine. They also invite villagers to join the celebration, but this time villagers do not have to give any donation, because they have already done so for the first child. Bunong parents tend to care and love their first baby more than others.</p>
